Nominations sought for a pre-LOU group to advise the Committee on Evaluation and Standards

Good co-ordination among the pre-LOUs will help both in the implementation of the standards set by the CES as well as helping those meeting the interim system requirements to work together during this phase. Such co-ordination and communication among the group would also help the transformation to the GLEIS, and may provide useful lessons for subsequent co-ordination among the LOUs. Consequently, a pre-LOU group is being formed to advise the CES. The subgroup will include one representative of each pre-LOU. The aim of the pre-LOU subgroup is to discuss common issues affecting pre-LOUs, particularly in relation to providing feedback on the development and implementation of the agreed ROC standards. The output of the group would feed into the regular CES discussions. The group will hold regular calls every 2 weeks. The calls will be set up by the LEI ROC Secretariat - the first call is expected to take place on 13 May. The CES would facilitate the work of the group, and the calls would be chaired by the Chair of the CES, Satoru Yamadera. The membership of the group will be providers of pre-LOU solutions that have been allocated a prefix by the ROC (or the FSB prior to the formation of the ROC). However, interested potential pre-LOUs which have not yet requested a prefix would be granted observer status.
